Statement of Commitment

5. Reporting and Whistleblowing

Employees and third parties are encouraged to report any concerns about unethical practices, including modern slavery, through our confidential whistleblowing channels. All reports will be treated seriously and investigated promptly.

6. Continuous Improvement

We review and update our policies, processes, and supplier engagement activities regularly to strengthen our prevention of modern slavery and promote transparency in our operations.
